3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spider diagram more or less complete. • Basic structure evident. • Attempt to include areas in need of support, each with at least one related charity.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spider diagram complete. • 5 areas supported by charities, each with two related charities. • Neatly laid out with all labelling complete. • ICT is used for layout
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Logos, graphics and images used to enhance effectiveness of the spider diagram. • Well laid out, good use made of the paper. • ICT enhances layout
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graphical work, use of logos and images of a high quality. • Logos, graphics and images are entirely relevant to charities and areas supported. • ICT used effectively to create eye catching spider diagram.
